OVERVIEW

Asbury's Summer College Ministry Internship Program is designed for a current college student or recent graduate who is seeking hands-on ministry experience with Asbury's Discipleship Team. The primary purpose of this position is to engage college-age young adults in a healthy and meaningful Christian community while growing in faith together. In addition, as part of this program, Asbury's staff will offer discipleship experiences and opportunities for the intern to grow in faith and relationship with the Lord. We want our intern to develop as a leader and a faithful witness for Christ.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must have a have a high school diploma.
- Two years removed from high school.
- Passion for college ministry and sharing Jesus with the next generation.
- Willingness to step outside of your comfort zone and serve in various areas of ministry.
- Ability to work well on a team.
- Pursuing a degree in a ministry related field is a plus, but not required.

EXPECTATIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Invest in your relationship with God and live in a way that reflects God's image as well. Live a life worth following both inside **and outside** the church.
- Build relationships appropriately with college-age young adults.
- Facilitate weekly college-age life groups/gatherings and help nurture faith formation and growth.
- Plan, organize, and host 2-3 events for college-age young adults.
- Work with the Asbury Missions Coordinator to plan college ministry mission opportunities and mobilize participants to serve.
- Develop social media content and promotional strategies alongside the Asbury Communications Team.
- Plan a December event for college-age young adults.

PAY: \$2,500 total for the summer.

HOURS: 40 hours per week.
