



945 (Sunday School) Volunteer

Youth Ministry

Overview: Your job is to build relationships with our youth and to help them engage with the teaching content.

Schedule:

9:30 Volunteer Huddle / 9:45 Youth Arrive / 10:00 Full Group Lesson / 10:50 Dismissal

Responsibilities:

- Prays for the youth regularly.
- Sunday School roles include:
 - Arriving in the RESET Space at 9:30am to join the Student Ministry Leaders in setting up before the first teenager arrives. We aim to be ready at 9:30am, 15 minutes before we start in case anyone arrives early.
 - Standing at the door greeting each teenager and their guardian/parent(s).
 - Learning each teenager's name.
 - Helping check each student in.
 - Handing out any necessary supplies.
 - Monitoring the students' conduct.
 - Taking pictures and videos for RESET's social media.
 - Leading pre-written Discussion Questions after the lesson.
- 945 Volunteers' consistent presence shows families that 945 is a welcoming and safe environment, that the emotional needs of the teenager are a priority and that the teenager can count on the love of a teacher who will lead the teenager to see, know and feel the love of God.
- 945 Volunteers work together with the Student Ministry Leaders to build a team of people who work in an effort to appropriately support a successful and excellent learning environment within that classroom.
- 945 Volunteers are informed of any special victories, concerns or challenges being faced by the student and their families and, as often as reasonable, pass that information on to the Graduate Resident of Student Ministry overseeing the teenager and youth ministry.
- 945 Volunteers have gone through the background check and volunteer training process and are adhering to the Safe Sanctuary policy of Asbury UMC.

Outside the weekly 945:

- As time allows, invest in connecting with youth outside of 945. Options include:
 - Attending trips and retreats.
 - Attending student events (games, meets, ceremonies).
 - Attending weekly Sunday night events.
 - Attending weekly Wednesday night Life Group events.
 - Other creative means of building appropriate relationships with the youth & parents have been sought.
