



# A NOTE FROM MIKE HOLLY

The fall brings with it many gifts: cooler temperatures, falling leaves, SEC football, and memorable holidays. At Asbury, the fall brings the opportunity to bless our community with Trunk or Treat, Advent, Christmas music and worship services, and many mission projects. This year, we have the added blessing of sending some of our Traditional Worship musicians and singers to New York City for a special Christmas Cantata at Carnegie Hall!

As I look back on the first three quarters of the year, it is amazing to see what God has done here at Asbury. We have launched Daily Bread Devotionals and 450 people read or listen to those devotionals every day. During Lent, we held our first-ever Lenten Art Exhibition featuring works from 30 artists depicting the events of Holy Week. We sent Asbury members to Costa Rica for a mission trip and are actively working to build a partnership for women's ministry in the churches there.

With only a bit of assistance from our church family, 363 children who attended VBS raised \$10,000 for Oak Mountain Missions in June. Additionally, Asbury Giggles & Grace had its biggest sale to date in February raising more than \$179,000 and donating \$13,500 worth of shopping coupons to 148 families in need. Anchor Community Respite Ministry blessed 1,000+ church members with prayer beads and baked 600 muffins for Together Sunday. And, the work of our small groups – like the United Methodist Women – never ceases, ensuring the needs of local children and teens are met with handmade crafts and essentials.

Rev. Michael Bowman and the Adult Ministry Staff have helped to launch Community Groups with a curriculum written by our own staff. Preparation for our second book is already underway.

And that is only part of the story of what God is doing at Asbury this year! Please remember that as we enter this final quarter of ministry and mission, your generosity is vital to keep everything going.
