A LETTER FROM MIKE

I was recently invited to serve as a mentor and speaker for new clergy in North Alabama at an upcoming retreat. It was an honor to be asked—not only because I care deeply about the future leaders our churches need, but also because it gave me an opportunity to play the same role others once played for me. When I began serving as a pastor twenty-two years ago, pastors and leaders throughout our area poured into Julie and me. Many of those mentors remain our friends today. They invested in us, helped us grow, and reminded us that ministry - and faith - were never meant to be experienced alone.

Albert Winseman, in his book *Growing an Engaged Church*, describes a pathway to church engagement. But first, what does “engagement” mean? Engagement happens when someone moves from spectator to participant - when the church stops being simply a place they attend and becomes a community where they belong and a mission in which they are personally invested. It isn’t merely about attendance, filling positions, or counting participation. It is about people worshipping, serving, and growing because they know they belong and want to contribute to what God is doing.



The pathway begins with four important questions:

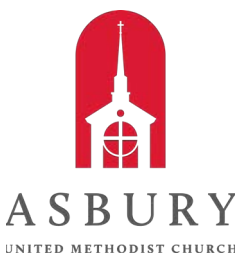
- **What do I get?** Are my spiritual needs being met by the church I attend?
- **What do I give?** Am I discovering opportunities to use my gifts and contribute in meaningful ways?
- **Do I belong?** Am I known, connected, and developing relationships with others?
- **How can we grow?** Am I fully invested in what the church is doing, where it is going, and how we can make a difference together?

This pathway is why we encourage everyone at Asbury to take three simple but powerful faith steps: worship, serve, and grow. These aren’t boxes to check. They are ways we become more deeply connected to God, one another, and the mission we share.

Nearly forty years ago, Asbury UMC was launched on November 23, 1986. Since then, generations of people have invested their time, talents, resources, and gifts to build a church that exists to help people embody the Way of Jesus. They belonged. They were engaged. They served. Our part in that legacy is to continue what they began as we worship, serve, and grow - together!

ANCHOR COMMUNITY RESPITE MINISTRY

Anchor Community Respite Ministry provides fellowship and stimulation to people who are living with memory loss. Anchor operates every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM at Asbury UMC.

The memory-loss program gives care partners a break each week to run errands, visit with friends, and rest. Care partners can participate in a monthly support group (which meets the first and third Thursday of each month) to share ideas and concerns with other care partners, as well as learn more from memory loss professionals. Care

partners are invited to call and schedule a tour of the Respite Care Center prior to enrollment.

- Sundays: Drop off items under the Angel Tree



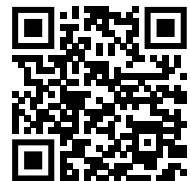
